

People Need Privacy

What is **“PRIVACY”**? What does that word mean?

PRIVACY means NO ONE looks at a person. The person should be alone and have **PRIVACY**.

A person must have **PRIVACY** when they are using the toilet. When a person is in the bathroom using the toilet that is a private thing.

It is **NOT** okay to watch people when they are doing private things. It is **NOT** okay to watch people when they are in a bathroom. **It is rude and wrong to watch people when they need privacy in a bathroom.**

Sometimes there are signs on bathrooms to tell us to **STAY OUT** because someone is in the bathroom and needs privacy. If the sign says **“OCCUPIED” that means stay out**, someone is in here. **If the sign says “Closed” that means stay out. If the sign says “IN USE” that means stay out.** Here are some signs.



If I see a sign I know to **stay out of the bathroom until someone comes out**. If I walk in this would be rude and wrong.

If there is no sign on a bathroom door then **I need to knock on the bathroom door** to be sure that no one is in the bathroom. If someone answers then I need to walk away from the door until the person comes out.

If I ever forget and walk into something that is private I must immediately walk away saying “Excuse me, I’m sorry” and then **leave that person alone**.

I NEED TO RESPECT OTHER PEOPLE’S PRIVACY. AND I WANT THEM TO RESPECT MY PRIVACY.
